Bio Snippet

Michele Milovina, M.D., FACOG grew up on the island of Maui and graduated valedictorian of her high school class at Seabury Hall College Preparatory Academy. Dr. Milovina knew at a very young age that she wanted to become an OBGYN and was able to get some hands on training as a teenager, helping to deliver babies at Maui Memorial Hospital. She graduated with honors from the University of California, Santa Barbara, with a bachelor in science degree in biopsychology. She then returned to her home state of Hawaii to complete her medical school training at the John A. Burns School of Medicine, where she was inducted into the Alpha Omega Alpha National Medical Honor Society.

After completing four years of medical school and deciding to pursue a career in women's health (and realizing she could never live too far from the ocean), Dr. Milovina began a four-year residency program in Obstetrics and Gynecology at the prestigious Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles, under the chairmanship of renowned perinatologist, Dr. Larry Platt.

Dr. Milovina has contributed to numerous articles and educational videos on pregnancy, and appeared in *Little Man*, a 2005 award-winning documentary film on preterm labor and premature birth. She has also received numerous awards during her career including the prestigious Janet M. Glasgow award for academic excellence in women's health. Additionally, Dr. Milovina was also honored by the March of Dimes and given the Prematurity Champion Award in 2015. Lastly, she is regularly honored as one of Los Angeles Magazine's Top Doctors, including in 2024. Dr. Milovina is board-certified, a process she maintains annually, and is a fellow of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists.

Dr. Milovina has been in private practice in Beverly Hills since 2002, and opened her own state of the art office in 2009. She has been an attending physician at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center since 2002 and regularly works with and teaches residents in training. Her clinical interest is in caring for women with high-risk pregnancies. Additionally, beginning in 2018, Dr. Milovina has traveled annually with Helps International to remote villages in Guatemala for 10 days at a time to provide poverty stricken populations of women with prenatal and gynecologic care, as well as life-saving gynecologic surgery. She also initiated the first midwife training course in rural Guatemala through Helps that she continues to teach annually. She and other OBGYNs help educate and train rural, lay midwives about postpartum hemorrhage, preeclampsia and other pregnancy and labor complications. She is married to Dr. Michael Sanchez, an anesthesiologist and is the mother of two delightful daughters, Leila and Ava.
